### HOW TO SPEAK UP

- Speak with your parents, a responsible adult or favorite teacher
- Use crime report lines that are anonymous, confidential, and discreet
- Reach out to your school officials or security/safety partners

- Speed up the response by getting the report to the right people

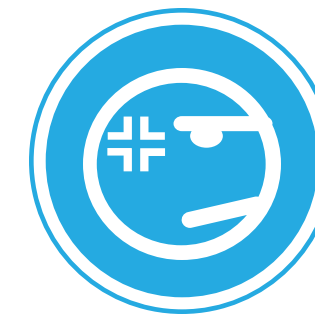
